ANTI GRAVEL COATING

Technical Information

It is used to form a strong elastic layer on the surface, resistant to impacts of stones and sand. Recommended for car sills. Provides long-term protection against water and corrosion. Protects against the effects of gasoline, oils and salts. Resistant to temperature changes. Has sound absorbing properties. The treated surface can be applied with all the paint systems.

How to use

Before use, carefully read the directions on the packaging and act accordingly.

Remove loose old lacquer and rust and sand the surface.

The surface should be clean, dry and free of grease.

Before use, shake the aerosol for 2 minutes and spray a sample. Distance to the surface to be treated approximately 25 to 30 centimetre.

Apply the several layers.

After use, clean the valve (turn aerosol upside down and press the nozzle for approximately 5 seconds).

Surfaces treated with "anti-gravel" should be painted earlier than 4–5 hours in advance

<u>Conditions of storage and transportation of products</u>: Products are transported by any ground mode of transport in compliance with the rules of cargo transportation. Products in packaged form must be stored in premises that protect products from chemical influences and mechanical damage at a temperature not lower than minus 20C and not higher than plus 40C.

Stability during storage: 5 years from the date of manufacture. The date of manufacture is indicated on the bottom of the aerosol.
