Technical Information

Penetrating Oil PITON — penetrating oil with rust converter for unlocking rusty and welded metal threaded connections: bolts, nuts, door hinges, lock mechanisms, etc. Penetrates into hard-to-reach places, lubricates detail and provides anti-corrosion protection. Restores the operability of movable metal nodes. Thanks to molybdenum disulfide and graphite in the composition, retains its lubricating properties even when the lubricant has evaporated from the surface.

How to use

Before use, carefully read the directions on the packaging and act accordingly.

Before use, shake the aerosol.

Apply the lubricant at any angle to the surface and leave for 2-3 minutes.

If necessary, repeat the processing and proceed to dismantling.

<u>Conditions of storage and transportation of products</u>: Products are transported by any ground mode of transport in compliance with the rules of cargo transportation. Products in packaged form must be stored in premises that protect products from chemical influences and mechanical damage at a temperature not lower than minus 20C and not higher than plus 40C.

Stability during storage: 5 years from the date of manufacture. The date of manufacture is indicated on the bottom of the aerosol.
